• *Early On System Review*

Michael Gillespie presented data from 13 sites that were monitored in FY 2005. The findings revealed that 85% of the issues were systematic. The data reinforces the need for *Early On* Redesign, which will address the issues the system is facing.

• *Early On Redesign*

Sheri Falvay and Maureen Greer presented information about where the *Early On* Redesign process is so far and what still needs to be completed. The SICC reviewed and commented on work from the Results Teams related to indicators, and the *Early On* Components.
